### **HEADLINE CHANGES TO THE MONTHLY INDICATORS**

Following consideration of the September economic down-turn report, no changes have been made to the data sets collected for the attached report (Appendix 1) prepared for the October 2009 SP Delivery Board.

### **TRENDS**

Based upon the last economic down-turn report in September, the following indicators are demonstrating a negative trend:

- Indicator 1: Commercial property vacancies.

- Indicator 7: Domestic Burglaries
- Indicator 9: Non-dwelling burglaries.

- Indicator 12: Referrals to SCC Welfare Rights Unit.
- Indicator 15: Number of individuals sleeping rough/imminent risk of.
- Indicator 16: Housing Benefit claimants.
